Newsletter No 50: 15 December 2019 Third Sunday of Advent Year A

"Be strong, do not fear ! Here is your God. ...He will come to Save you."

Today we rejoice as we wait in hope for the Coming of the Lord.

Someone remarked to me, when we spoke of the difficult circum-stances that people were going through: "I don't know how people can cope when they don't have our Catholic faith that gives us something to hold on to !"

It is true – that God gives us so much reason to hope when things look grim, or in times of illness or darkness.

In the readings today – God tells us that the future is bright and full of hope. It is for us to trust God - to have faith in his Promises.

Isaiah (chap. 35) sees God coming to save his People, bringing them home from exile. Even the desert places will bloom with flowers. Then the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped -God's people will be singing for joy, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.

The second reading (James) tells us to be patient: "Strengthen your hearts for the coming of the Lord is near!"

Jesus assures the disciples of John the Baptist, when they question if he really is the Messiah. "Look at my works! Go and tell John what you hear and see . . the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the deaf hear again, the lepers are cleansed and the poor have good news brought to them. And blessed is he who does not lose faith in me!"

Jesus came to lift up his People, to bring them home and to banish sin and sadness. He came to save us – to give us a future full of hope.

As we await the Feast of Christmas, let us keep patient and in gentle spirits to one another. The Lord is coming to save our tired, broken world. He is still working to make that Kingdom come. We must keep up our faith in Him. He is coming to Save us His People.
