## Lest We Forget

This weekend, and especially on Sunday, we pause and remember with gratitude those sons of Marlborough and Kaikoura who gave their lives in the two Great Wars of the Twentieth Century, 1914 – 1918 and 1939 – 1945. Many will argue the point about what they were fighting for - 'for King and country'; `for the defence and well-being of their loved ones from foreign powers?' For freedom ? Often just following orders!!

Every war has its complexities, its divided lovalties, its political machinations. Yet, I believe, for a Christian who is fighting for his country and his loved ones "as he perceives it", he or she is sharing in the sacrifice of the Good Shepherd.
