#### The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord Mark: 16:15 - 20

"So then the Lord, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. And they went out and proclaimed the good news everywhere"

Today we celebrate the final coming of Our Lord into his Glory with the Father. It is really an extension of his Resurrection. As he has Risen triumphant from the tomb, now he is Raised up in Glory to be in power with his Father and the Holy Spirit.

This feast fills us with Hope. As Christ has conquered death and sin, we too are assured that we who follow him and our creation too, will share in his victory. Over the last year, we have seen much that likes to kill all hope – the terrible harm that the pandemic has made in killing many many thousands of people, so many even in our own country have lost their jobs, we see the shame and terrible abuse of children and youth, even by clergy, that causes deep wounds in innocent youth and damages the good name of the Church; we see the falling numbers of those who attend church – and growth of secularism in our society, we see the increase of global warming that threatens the future of our planet. All these things could cause us to say, "God has abandoned us. What is the use of going on living?" Yet, despite these dark clouds, we have every reason to be people of hope.

Jesus has Risen from the dead, and as man – the first fruits of the New Creation, he sits at the right hand of the Father in glory. Where he has gone before, we too are called to follow. As the prayer for today says: "May we follow him into the new creation, for his ascension is our glory and our hope."

The Church is both human and divine. As we have suffered with Christ, we too will reign with Christ in his Glory.

Let us be people of hope. May God's blessing and presence fill you and your family with a joy that no one can take from you.
