Reflection on Sunday Gospel - Matthew 5:17-37 By Sister Verna Holyhead, SGS.

"In his autobiography, Long Walk to Freedom, Nelson Mandela writes about the wardens who guarded him and the other prisoners and their essential humanity.

He believed that hostility towards them was self-defeating, and that everyone, even our enemies, can change.

On February 11, 1990, the day that Mandela was to be released from prison after twenty-seven and a half years, the crowd that gathered throughout the world who were watching TV became anxious as the time for his release was well past. Would he not walk free after all? But he did, and the reason for the long delay was because he was saying an emotional goodbye to his guards.

In his freedom speech that night, Mandela reminded the world that we can all imprison ourselves behind the bars of prejudice and narrow-mindedness."

"As I walked out the door toward the gate that would lead to my freedom, I knew if I didn't leave my bitterness and hatred behind, I'd still be in prison."
