Dear Parishioners

Last weekend we celebrated the 150th Jubilee of Saint Mary's School. Special thanks to Archbishop Paul Martin, SM, for his pastoral visit – he returns in August to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at Saint Mary's, Blenheim, and Sacred Heart, Kaikoura. Classes for Confirmation preparation begin next weekend. Please remember to register at the parish office if you have not already done so.

This week we celebrate Matariki on Friday. It marks the Māori New Year which begins each year with the rising of the cluster of nine stars that appear in the middle of winter. The Matariki Star signifies time for reflection, health

and wellbeing, hope and family. Traditionally Matariki is a time for remembrance, especially of those who have died in the past year. It is also a time of celebration with food and family/whanau. Ground is prepared and seeds saved from last year's harvest are planted for the coming year.

I was struck by one of the Māori sayings for Matariki:

"Hoki whakamuri kia anga whakamua."

Notice how similar it was to the School Motto of Saint Mary's:

"In Christ's Light – Honouring Our Past – Building Our Future."
