**National Vocations Awareness Week - Lives of Service, Lives of Joy** "God calls you to make definitive choices, and he has a plan for each of you: to discover that plan and to respond to your vocation is to move toward personal fulfilment. God calls each of us to be holy, to live his life, but he has a particular path for each one of us." Pope Francis - WYD July 2013

Our baptism calls us to holiness. We live out this call through marriage, single life, priesthood or consecrated life. National Vocations Awareness Week (4-11 August) is an annual event set aside by the Bishops of New Zealand, focusing our attention on all forms of vocation in the Church.

Please pray for all those in our Archdiocese who are discerning their vocation, including our three seminarians Alfred, Kinh and Matthew, and Emilio who is preparing to enter Seminary next year. May we all be open to God's call and respond with generosity and courage.

This week the Catholic Bishops of New Zealand call us to think, pray and talk about Vocations to the ordained ministry and to religious life.

Recently I attended our Provincial Chapter for the Passionists in Melbourne. A feature of it was the many young men – mainly from Papua New Guinea and Viet Nam who are studying fro the priesthood or religious life. There was also one – Luke Buley – who is studying for the Passionist priesthood from Australia. None from New Zealand ! Slim pickings for vocations to the priesthood here in New Zealand and Australia. Why is that ?

I believe young people still have a spirit of great generosity. One young woman last year made her Profession to the Sisters of the Cross and Passion in Melbourne. She is Karen, from Palmerston North. Three young men are in Auckland studying for the priesthood for our Archdiocese – Alfred, Kinh and Matthew, as well as Emilio who is preparing to enter the seminary next year. They need the help of our prayers.

We hear in the Gospel about a man who spent his life storing up more wealth for himself. He decides to build bigger barns to store all his grain and his belongings. That night God tells him: "You fool! This very night your life is demanded of you. And the things you have prepared, whose will they be?"

That is why God wants more people who will seriously be willing to see if they have a call (vocation) to be a priest or a religious brother or sister, so that we can call people to their true vocation – to be holy in Christ. In the priesthood, we call people to respond to God's call for them to store up treasure for themselves in heaven. We deal in a product that endures for eternal life !

Let us pray the Rosary this week, and pray that people even in our Parish of Star of the Sea will seriously look at where God is calling them to be of service to God and to others.
