Baptised and Sent

This month we want to respond to the Call of Pope Francis to reignite and reawaken our baptismal commitment that as members of the Church, we are called to participate with Gospel joy in realizing the mission of God.

As Pope Francis writes: "Celebrating this month will help us first to rediscover the missionary dimension of our faith in Jesus Christ, a faith graciously bestowed on us in baptism. Our filial relationship with God is not something simply private, but always in relation to Church. Through our communion with God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we, together with so many of our oth-er brothers and sisters, are born to new life. This divine life is not a product for sale—we do not practice proselytism—but a treasure to be given, communicated and proclaimed: this is the meaning of mission. We received this gift freely and we share it freely (cf. Mt 10:8), without excluding anyone.

Today the Church in the Word of God focuses on prayer. We see Moses as a type of Jesus the High Priest, our one Mediator between God and mankind as he lifts up his hands in prayer to God when the people were hard-pressed in fighting their enemies the Amalekites.

Our prayer too has a missionary dimension. God alone can make our efforts succeed. God alone can make his Reign, the kingdom of God, grow in our hearts, in our relationships and in our communities.

Jesus called on us in the Gospel to be persistent in prayer-" to prayer always and not to lose heart"

Let us pray for our Bishops and Cardinal John as they are soon in Rome to meet with Pope Francis. Let us pray for those who are victims of abuse, sexual or otherwise in the Church. Let us pray for Bishop Charles Drennan who has resigned from the Diocese of Palmerston North.

Let us pray for our missionaries who take the Gospel to people in other countries.

Let us also be generous to help the Mission of the Church by our contributions on this Mission Sunday.
