Praying from the Heart

Jesus tells us in the parable about two men who go to the temple to pray. One prays in a good way, the other prays in a poor ,wrongful way. So Jesus tells us that not all prayer is good!

The first man comes in and tells God what a fine fellow he is-

"God, I thank you that I am not like other people: thieves, rogues, adulterers, or even like this tax collector." Then he tells God all the great things he has been doing.

But Jesus said God did not listen to his prayer. He was so full of himself.

The second man— stands a long way near the back of the temple, dares not look up at all, and beats his breast as he says: "God be merciful to me, a sinner."

Jesus says that this man went home at rights with God. God heard his prayer, because he prayed humbly before God and others.

When we come before God it is good to be completely honest and open with God. We cannot fool him. He knows us through and through.

We don't have to be like Uriah Heep, the man who had false humility in the story by Charles Dickens. He told everyone how "'umble I am" but secretly tried to betray the others around him.

True humility knows that we depend completely on God. That we cannot boast of anything. When we pray—just let us

"Come as you are That's how I need you. Come as you are, be right at home"

as the song goes. God loves you and welcomes you. Just let us be ourselves—warts and all before our loving God. And he accepts the prayer of a humble and contrite heart. May God bless us all.
