"Do not be afraid – you are of more value than many sparrows." (Mat. 10: 26 – 33)

Sometimes in life, we can feel powerless when nothing seems to be going right. We can feel forgotten and even afraid, when we fear some outcome, or fear for our loved ones, or everything seems to be 'turning to custard'.

Jesus tells us to realise that "He has the whole world in his hands," and we must continue to trust in his Love and Presence.

Sometimes we may <u>feel</u> that God has forgotten us, but that is not so – Jesus assures us that we are still God's beloved children, and God knows the littlest details of our life.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus which was celebrated on Friday has a very similar message: -

Jesus says, "Come to me, all you who labour and are heavy burdened, and I will give you rest. Learn from Me . . . " Jesus calls us to trust in his Love and Mercy and he will help us through the rough patches.

Even though we can appear to be in a no-win situation, Jesus our Lord can pull victory out of the jaws of defeat (like a drop-kick in the last minute of the game!).

So trust in Our Blessed Lord or turn to Mary our Mother. Listen to him in your heart. realise too, that developing one's relationship with the Lord is a twoway street. Maybe he is asking you to let go of some attachment that is sinful. But never doubt his love for you.

" Fear not little flock. You are worth more than many sparrows!"
