The Parable of the Sower

"Listen! A sower went out to sow"

Matthew 13: 1 – 23

In a way, the Gospel today is like Jesus taking a 'selfie' of what he is doing. He is in a village near the Sea of Galilee. He was sitting by the sea, and such great crowds came and gathered around him that he gets into a boat and sat there, while all the people stood on the beach.

He tells them a parable, a word-picture which describes his task being like a farmer who throws seed around him as he walks through his field. Jesus himself is the Sower and he describes the different kinds of response people make when they hear the word.

Some seed fell on the path and the birds came and eat them up. This is when the evil one – Satan – comes and snatches away what was sown. Some people have no interest in the Word of Life.

Some seed fell on rocky ground, where the soil has no depth, and when the sun bore down, the plants withered away. They had no root. Jesus explains – this is like the one who hears the word and receives it with joy, but such a person has no staying power, and when some trouble or persecution arise, that person falls away. And so on, Jesus describes the various ways in which people respond to the Word of Life which he brings.

He really challenges us to think – "What kind of soil am I?" Do I welcome the word and use it profitably for my spiritual growth, or do I say: "Boring . . . boring . . . I can't make any money out of this." And the Word gets lost.

Let us take note of the punch line: "Let anyone with ears listen!" It is not enough to listen to a sermon or to read a passage of Scripture. I must mull it over, wrestle with it like a dog with a bone, so that the Word sinks into my heart and produces good fruit.

The Word of Jesus can give me joy; it can change my life. It can make me a Giver, not a Taker. It can make me like the merchant who finds a pearl of great price.
