We all know the ritual of handing over keys as a symbol of authority which is recorded in our reading from Isaiah. This action gives a deeper insight into Jesus' teaching about the Kingdom of Heaven as the incident at Caesarea Philippi relates.

Jesus' questioning and response corrects and enhances what the disciples have learnt on the road. Peter's response is a parallel statement about Jesus' handing over the keys to him in his new leadership role.

Peter, despite being blessed by God for the role leadership, is confronted with its implications e.g. constant example, the stresses and strains of service. As Peter is reminded, so too are we, that it is the Lord's call to lead but in his ways.
