Dear Parishioners,

Today, Palm Sunday, we officially begin holy week. Palm Sunday is the remembrance of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem in which he is honoured as the Messiah. It is a procession full of expectant hope and jubilation. As it is portrayed in the gospels it is reminiscent of King

David's victory procession into Jerusalem where people placed palms on the ground in front of him.

Our own procession with palms reminds us how this celebration is tinged with

sadness in the light of Jesus' passion. Faith in the resurrection acknowledges human

complicity in the condemnation and crucifixion of Jesus. What we celebrate in Holy week is not a his-

torical, step-by-step re-enactment, but a placing of ourselves within the living drama of the passion. As church we celebrate the mystery of Christ's dying and rising as a **present** reality of Gods forgiving love. Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem to accomplish his paschal mystery is a reminder to us of his call to model his love.

The world at the moment seems to have had more than its share of suffering and deeply painful issues to contend with. As a people of faith we are called to trust in God through Jesus Christ. We are called,
