
Christ is risen; Ua toe tu le Keriso; Cristo ha resucitado; Mabuhay muli si Kristo; Kua ara te Karaiti.

Today is the day of Resurrection – Jesus is our Lord and Saviour and he is risen from the dead. ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA!

Throughout the last few days we have journeyed as individuals, as a community of faith and as part of the worldwide Church with Jesus.
