Hardened to Difficulties

"I will strengthen and harden you to difficulties; yes, I will help you." - Isaiah 41:10

If you had faced some of the challenges you encounter today twenty years ago, they might have overwhelmed you. God knows your capacity to handle adversity. As you continue to overcome these tests, He is toughening you against difficulties. You are growing stronger; your faith is deepening, and your endurance is increasing. Your spiritual muscles are being built up.
