Newsletter 33, 7th September 2025 23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

What does it mean for *me* to be a Christian? We measure people's commitment to a cause by the sacrifices they are prepared to make for it. There are people who have great goals in life, but they will never achieve these goals, because they are not willing to pay the price. In the Gospels we can see that Jesus didn't hide the realities from his disciples. He pointed out the difficulties, the hardships, and the sacrifices that would be required of those who would follow him, and we cannot hope to be followers of Christ *without* making sacrifices. Jesus had one great goal in His life; to carry out the task his Father had given him. And he was willing to pay whatever the price demanded in order to fulfil his goal.

There is a cost to discipleship. Jesus doesn't mean we should literally hate our mother and father. He is telling us we need to be ready to sacrifice the dearest things in life, because the goal that Jesus sets before us is immensely worthwhile - the goal of an authentic life here, and an eternal life hereafter. It is not easy, but no one can be a disciple without carrying the cross in some way. Our lives are often not easy, sometimes difficult, but Jesus knows our weaknesses and frailties and showers us with his grace when we sincerely work to follow him.
